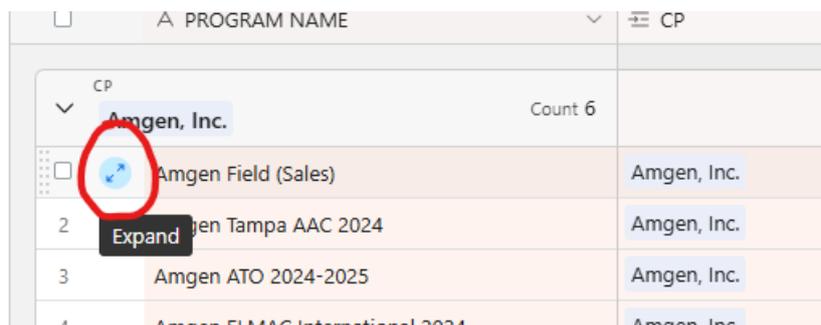
*Reminder: once program and assignment data is OFFICIAL it is entered into the GAP Tracker for data/historical tracking.*
